



CREATICITY: Lowell Art & Maker Festival

September 16 & 17, 2017

Festival Logistics, Street Closings and Traffic Patterns

Lowell will be celebrating the arts and culture community with CREATICITY: Lowell Art & Maker Festival, which will take place on Market Street in downtown. This free festival will be on the weekend of September 16-17 and be open to the public from 12:00pm to 6:00pm each day. Lowell's first Art & Maker Festival will feature artists, makers, stage and street performers, workshops, public art and more!

To accommodate the festival setup and the event, most of Market Street will be closed from Friday, September 15th at 4:00pm until 11:59 pm Sunday September 17th.

Meters will be bagged "No Parking" beginning Thursday night and all cars will have to be removed by Friday afternoon at 4pm. Any cars left at metered spots after 4:00pm Friday will be towed. Traffic will not be allowed on Market Street from the edge of 57 Market Street (Bridgewell) all the way to the end of the Market Mills Park. There will be access from the Central Street end of Market Street to the TD Bank Parking Lot. Additionally, Market Street will be open from Dutton Street to the end of the National Park building (which includes access from Shattuck Street).

Access to and from the Leo Roy Garage on Market Street and the Canal Place driveway will be via Middle Street to Palmer Street. Palmer will be converted into a temporary two way street from Middle Street to Market Street. A police detail will be present to direct traffic, and there will be signage to direct residents and visitors. *There will be no access to the Market Street garage or Canal Place from the Dutton end of Market Street.*

Emergency vehicles will be able to access all roads and buildings during those times if necessary.

Market St will reopen to traffic no later than 11:59pm Sunday night once everything has been removed.
